Hello,

I would like to take a moment of your time to introduce myself and the new Army Recruiting Station located on Panzer Kaserne of Stuttgart, Germany. My name is SFC Corey L. Gavin and I have been in the Army for fourteen years which nine of those I have dedicated myself to the assistance of aiding the enlistment of new Soldiers into the service of the U.S. Army. As of March 1, 2011 the Stuttgart Recruiting Station has been in operation and will be in operation for a very long time. The stations area includes: Stuttgart; Mannheim; all of Italy; and all areas in between. Now, I would like to take some more of your valuable time to inform you of what the Army can do for you now and in your future. But, before I get to that, I would like you to know the Army is a key component of the U.S. Armed Forces and is made up of the best-trained, most dedicated, most respected Soldiers in the world – protecting America's freedoms at home and abroad, securing our homeland, and defending democracy worldwide. As a Soldier in the Army, you have several options when you join. No matter which option you choose, you're showing your commitment to your country and yourself – and you'll be an important part of the world's most powerful Army.

First choice is Active Duty: Serving Full Time

1. The Army strengthens you, and your future, with expert training in over 150 different jobs. From working with computers to assisting physicians, there's a job for you!
2. The training and salary you get as a Soldier are only some of the benefits you receive from the Army; you also get money for education, health care, vacation time, family services and support groups, cash allowances for the cost of living, etc...
3. Qualified Active Duty recruits may be eligible for a one-time bonus up to \$40,000!
4. The MGIB and the ACF are designed to help you pay for your college education. When you enlist in the Army with a job you choose, you can get up to \$85,536 for college education.
5. The loan Repayment Program (LRP) is an enlistment incentive offered to qualified applicants at the time of enlistment. The Army will pay one-third of your loan for each year of service.
6. The Army offers several opportunities for Soldiers to achieve their education goals. You can attend a four-year university either through online or in a high-tech learning facility on Army installations.
7. In the Active Army, your length of service can range from two to six years.

Second choice is Army Reserve: Serving When Needed

1. The Army Reserve is more like a part-time job that enables you to keep your civilian career while you serve your country. Many professionals and college students are Soldiers in the Army Reserve.
2. There is no limit to the opportunities, no limit to what you can learn, and no limit to what you can achieve with over 120 jobs in the Army Reserve.
3. Qualified Army Reserve recruits may be eligible for a one-time bonus up to \$20,000!
4. The Selected Reserve MGIB is designed to help you pay for up to \$12,132 of your college education needs.
5. If you qualify and accept a critical position, you can receive an additional MGIB Kicker up to \$24,732; may vary according to job and rank.
6. The PaYS program offers qualified recruits the opportunity to secure an interview, with priority consideration, with over 350 American corporations and public agencies nationwide!
7. In the Army Reserve, your length of service can range from three to six years.
