



Vision & Hearing Screening

The functions of the MS/HS Nurse include health services, health counseling and consultation, and health education.

"Health Services" include screening programs for vision, hearing and scoliosis. When students are in grades 6-12, screenings are done according to DODDS policy, which states that screenings are done every 3 years, to include at least one screening in the high school years. Additionally, if you have a concern about your child's vision or hearing, and would like me to screen him, please feel free to call and I will schedule him/her for an appointment.

If the student does not pass the screening, a referral letter with the screening results will be given to the student to take home, and I will try to contact the parent to request that a follow-up appointment with the appropriate physician be made as soon as possible. The form will have a bottom section to be signed by the physician and returned to me after the appointment.

Because any substantial reduction in seeing or hearing constitutes a handicap in learning, I urge you to follow through with the referral process in a timely manner. If you have any concerns, please feel free to call me @ (DSN) 634-7584 during regular school hours.

Be aware that these screenings do not eliminate the need for annual exams for your child by his/her physician.
