

POLICIES



Students who are ill or injured, or who need to see the School Nurse must have a pass from a teacher or the office except, of course, in case of emergency! Students in-between classes should go to their next period teacher to get a pass before coming to the nurse's office. No pass is required during lunchtime until 5 minutes before class begins again.



If there is a medical emergency and the nurse is not available, students should go next door to the Administration Office.



Medical verification is needed to excuse a student from PE. Parents will be contacted if there is a medical problem or injury which arises during the school day that prevents a student from PE participation.



No student will be sent home ill or injured without parent consent or the consent of the "emergency contact person" designated by parent on the health form. Every attempt will be made to contact the parent(s) first.

Health counseling includes encouraging students to be self-reliant in the personal health care and assisting with referrals to the Teen Clinic and other medical or community agencies. It includes individual and group health instruction, personal guidance and cooperation with home and community through parent conferences, and participation with community committees. The school nurse is one of the persons in the school who is a designated contact person for referral of students suspected of alcohol and/or drug abuse and suspected or alleged child abuse and any allegations or ideations of suicide.
